Dear Secretary Walther:

The American Rescue Plan of 2021 (ARP) was adopted by Congress earlier this year and provides significant federal funding to states through various programs. Among these programs is funding to support the deployment of high-speed broadband service to rural communities.

Presently, the Arkansas Department of Commerce Broadband Office oversees the Arkansas Rural Connect (ARC) program, including oversight of incoming federal grants to facilitate the deployment of high-speed broadband service to rural communities across Arkansas. To date, ARC has made 132 awards from multiple funding sources, including from state funds, from CARES Act funds, and from ARP funds since SFY 2020. Awarding of grants is an ongoing process with the support of new, incoming ARP funding for "shovel ready" or "near shovel ready" projects. Additionally, to support outside technical consulting services, \$6.5M has been budgeted for professional fees.

The Department of Commerce respectfully requests \$124,766,142 in ARP funding for the ARC program for SFY 2022. This will be in addition to the earlier ARP funding requests that total \$185M that have already been granted this calendar year. Upon steering committee approval, the department will then seek review and approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council of the funding request, as well as necessary spending appropriation. This amount will continue to help support broadband construction projects currently in development across Arkansas.
