

## ARKANSAS INDIVIDUAL INCOME TAX CAPITAL GAINS

In Arkansas, only 50% of the net capital gain is taxed. 100% of the short term capital gain is taxed.

Per Act 1488 of 2013, the amount of net capital gain in excess of ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) from a gain realized on or after January 1, 2014, is exempt from state tax.

Complete the AR1000D if you have a CAPITAL GAIN OR LOSS reported on federal Schedule D, or if Schedule D is not required, a gain reported on federal Form 1040, line 7. The amount of capital loss that can be deducted after offsetting capital gains is limited to \$3,000 (\$1,500 per taxpayer for filing status 4 or 5). See instructions for line 14, Form AR1000F/AR1000NR.

Adjust your gains and losses for depreciation differences, if any, in the federal and Arkansas amounts using lines 2, 5 and 10. \*

Note: Arkansas did not adopt the federal "bonus depreciation" provision from previous years. Therefore, there may be a difference in federal and Arkansas amounts of depreciation allowed.
