The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Intergovernmental Services has a funding opportunity under the Residential Substance Abuse Treatment for State Prisoners (RSAT) Program. This funding is geared to assist county jails, detention facilities and prison units to provide incarcerated inmates treatment for drug addiction. In addition, it prepares inmates for re-entry to their communities with after-care services.

Our office is committed to assist your organization through-out the grant cycle. Our commitment will include workshops, technical assistance, on-site visits, and one-on-one technical assistance to ensure your program is a success. This grant has a 25% match requirement that can be cash or in-kind. For example: if you have a security officer that is paid with other funds and will monitor inmates in the substance abuse program, a portion of the salary can be used as in-kind match.
