The Arkansas Medical Marijuana Commission meeting was called to order by Chairman James Miller at 4:30 p.m. on March 3, 2022. Chairman Miller along with Commissioners Russell, Case and Thomas appeared via conference call. Commissioner Mobley joined the meeting via conference call at 4:33 p.m. The meeting room was open to the public for attendance with Director Doralee Chandler along with staff attorney Chip Leibovich present in the room. The January 2022 minutes were reviewed. Commissioner Russell made a motion to approve the minutes which was seconded by Chairman Miller and passed 4-0. Permit 40 Fiddler's Green 's change of floor plan was withdrawn by the permittee. Director Chandler presented the remaining notice items consisting of Permit 88 Natural State Medicinals' change of floor plan, Permit 249 Natural Relief's change of floor plan, Permit 358 3J Investments, Inc.'s name change to Good Day Farm Van Buren, and Permit 327 Shake Extractions' change of floor plan.

Next on the agenda was the change of ownerships. First on the list was Permit 123 Good Day Farm Arkansas. The change of ownership was presented. Attorney Michael Goswami was present to respond to questions by the Commission. Commissioner Case made a motion to approve the application which was seconded by Commissioner Russell and passed 4-0. Permit 126 Capital City Medicinals was presented next. Mr. Goswami was present to answer questions related to this application as well.
