The November 10, 2022, Medical Marijuana Commission meeting was called to Order by Chairman James Miller at 4:30 p.m. Chairman Miller appeared in person for the meeting and Commissioners Case, Mobley, Russell, and Thomas appeared via the Go-To link provided. Upon review of the minutes Commissioner Russell made a motion to approve which was seconded by Commissioner Mobley and carried 5-0. Director Chandler presented the Notice Items which consisted of a change of floor plan submitted by Permit 70 Leafology. The next agenda items discussed were the changes of ownership submitted. The first one reviewed was Permit 120 Carpenter Farms. After consideration and review of the documents, Chairman Miller made a motion to grant the request which was seconded by Commissioner Russell and carried 5-0. The second change of ownership presented was by Permit 158 Enlightened for People – Morrilton. After consideration and review of the documents, Commissioner Case made a motion to grant the request which was seconded by Commissioner Mobley and carried 5-0. The last change of ownership considered was for Permit 258 Good Day Farm – Van Buren. After consideration and review of the documents, Commissioner Russell made a motion to grant the request which was seconded by Commissioner Case and carried 5-0.

The change of location request by Permit 46 Arkansas Natural Products was removed from the agenda at the request of the permittee. The last agenda items discussed were the Administrative Matters. Daniel Faulkner with the Office of the Attorney General provided a litigation update to the Commission. Upon conclusion of any discussion regarding the litigation update, the next meeting was scheduled for December 1, 2022, and Chairman Miller subsequently adjourned the meeting.
