Withholding Tax Section

Beginning January 1, 2020, the Employer's Income Tax Withholding Tax Tables have been adjusted with an effective date of March 1, 2020 as a result of Income Tax reductions enacted by the General Assembly. The new tax tables, instructions and computer formula can be found on the Department's web site at: <u>Withholding Tax</u>

The tables and computer formula should be used for all payroll periods ending on or after March 1, 2020. The change in the tax table will reduce the amount of State Withholding from an employee's paycheck. If an employee wants to remain at their current level of Withholding, a new Employee's Withholding Exemption Certificate (form AR-4EC) should be completed and submitted to the employer. To change the employee's withholding amount, complete Line #4 on the AR-4EC by entering a dollar amount the employee would like withheld in addition to the tax amount already being withheld.

Explanation of Tax Adjustment Letter

The primary purpose of the Explanation of Tax Adjustment letter is to inform the taxpayer that an adjustment has been made to his/her tax return and a summary of the return after adjustments have been made. It does not include any payments made with or after the return was processed. Payments will be reflected on the Notice of Proposed Assessment letter or a Notice of Final Assessment letter.

Additionally, there is a statement below the summary that explains the adjustment, such as "Error in amount claimed as estimated tax paid or credit carried forward from previous tax year". Adjustments could be made for several reasons such as a math error, an error in calculating estimated payments or credit brought forward, a disallowance of a deduction or credit, or an adjustment made due to an IRS audit.

At the bottom of the Explanation of Tax Adjustment letter is a note explaining the adjustment letter is not a bill. Below is the note that is included in all Adjustment letters. Please note the items in bold. **THIS IS NOT A BILL**

Payments submitted with your return are not included in the Total Payments show above. If these adjustments result in any additional tax liability, you will receive a Notice of Proposed Assessment which will show all previous payments, any balance due for tax, interest and penalty, and will include a payment voucher. Any credit or refund will be reduced by outstanding balances on your account.

The Explanation of Tax Adjustment Letter is meant to be read in its entirety to ensure the taxpayer understands the status of his or her tax return and the purpose of the letter. Should the taxpayer have additional questions concerning this letter or any correspondence received from the tax department there is a person's name and contact information at the bottom of all correspondence. I would encourage the taxpayer to call (501) 682-1000 if there is any confusion.

Motor Vehicle Services

ACT 733 of 2019: Arkansas will begin Titling <u>NEW</u> boats in January 2020. This will only effect <u>NEW</u> boats registered with Manufactured Statement of Origin and Manufactured in 2020. Effective: January 1, 2020

The Office of Motor Vehicle, the Office of Driver Services and the International Registration Plan (IRP) Office, are offering services online. All these services are available on the Department of Finance and Administration (DFA's) website at: <u>mydmv.arkansas.gov</u>

<u>Check Title Status Online</u> – This service will help taxpayers to check the status of their application for title.

<u>**Transfer Ownership**</u> – This service will help taxpayers to notify the Office of Motor Vehicles (OMV) if they have sold their vehicle to another individual or to a dealer.

<u>Print Duplicate Registration</u> – This service will help taxpayers to print a duplicate registration online.

<u>Estimated Sales Tax Calculator</u> – This service will allow taxpayers to calculate how much state tax they will owe for a vehicle before registration.

<u>Online Pre-Registration</u> – This service will allow taxpayers to input specific Motor Vehicle details and receive a confirmation code for submission. The taxpayer should present the confirmation code and necessary documents to their local State Revenue Office clerk to complete the transaction with minimal data input.

<u>Vehicle Registration</u> - This service will allow taxpayers to register their vehicle online and "SKIP THE TRIP" to their local revenue office. User will enter Motor Vehicle details, pay sales tax, mail documents and obtain a confirmation code. The plate and registration will be mailed once documents have been received, reviewed and approved.

Office of Motor Fuel Tax

Tax Act Update

Effective October 1, 2019 there is a wholesale sales tax on motor fuel for an additional 3 cents on gasoline and 6 cents per gallon on diesel. Act 416 was passed in the 92nd General Assembly Regular Session of 2019. This Act will increase the overall tax rate for Motor Fuel to 24.5 cents a gallon for gasoline and 28.5 cents a gallon for diesel.

Arkansas is taking part in the federal nationwide initiative to improve the security of state-issued driver's licenses and identification cards, which will help fight terrorism and reduce identity fraud. On October 1, 2020, anyone who boards a domestic flight or enters a federal building will either need a REAL ID driver's license (DL) or Identification Card (ID) or will need to provide a regular identification and additional accepted forms of identification.

- Change a name on an account.

- Amend a return.
- Maintain all tax account types via a single login.
- Assign 3rd party logins (CPA, power of attorney, responsible party, & etc.).
- Store banking information for use during payment submission.
- Upload w-2 information.
- View tax period financial information (tax penalty, interest, credits, balance, & etc.).
- View payments received.
- View recent account activity.
- View correspondence from the department.
- Certify Tax Credits Payroll, Expenditures and/or Tax Back Refund request.
