ELIGIBILITY:

Eligible entities are State agencies and local jurisdictions (municipalities/counties). Entities who are eligible to apply directly to DOJ/BJA are eligible to apply; however, priority will be given to municipalities/counties that were identified as ineligible to apply directly to Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA). All applying entities must have an active UEI.

APPLICATION DEADLINE:

Applications and supporting documentations are due **Monday**, **October 10**, **2022** to Department of Finance and Administration-Intergovernmental Services (DFA-IGS). Application submitted by mail should be postmarked no later than October 10, 2022 or electronic submission to IGS.Applications@dfa.arkansas.gov by the deadline.
